Q) What can you tell us about the murder of Brenda Way?

A) I saw Brenda on the afternoon before she was found dead. It was around dinner time. She was hitch hiking on Prince Albert Rd in front of the Irving Station. She never looked happy. I asked her if she was short of cash. She said, No, I'm out here trying to get some.

Q) Was that the last time you saw her alive?

A) Yes.

Q) Do you know anything else that she did that night?

A) I know that she went to the crackhouse at 88 Windmill Rd #2, Laura Marsh's place. I missed her by a couple of minutes, sometime between 2am and 3am. A) No.


